What is a Swim-a-thon?
Swimmers seek sponsorship and take part in a team swim to raise money for BSUH Charity. Each team will swim for 55 minutes in one lane with only one person swimming at once, usually one lengths at a time and only for as many lengths as they can manage.

How to enter a team

Each team will consist of a minimum of 5 people and all swimmers must be competent in water to a depth of ____ metres. Having decided to enter a team, the next step is to fill out the entry form opposite and return it asap: spaces are limited!

Acceptance and sponsorship forms will be sent by email and teams should then begin to seek sponsorship. An entry fee of £25 is required for each team; this can be paid by cheque or online. (INSERT link)

On the Day

Each team will swim for 55 minutes with start times at hourly intervals from 13:00 until 15:00. Teams may organise their relay of swimmers in whatever way they think fit. There is no requirement for each team member to shoulder an equal amount of the work, on a need for the team swimming to be constant and unbroken in the lane allocated to them for the entire 55 minutes.

Sponsorship

All money raised will go to BSUH Charity, a local charity that supports care given at Royal Sussex County Hospital, Eye Hospital, Royal Alexandra Children's Hospital and Princess Royal Hospital.
