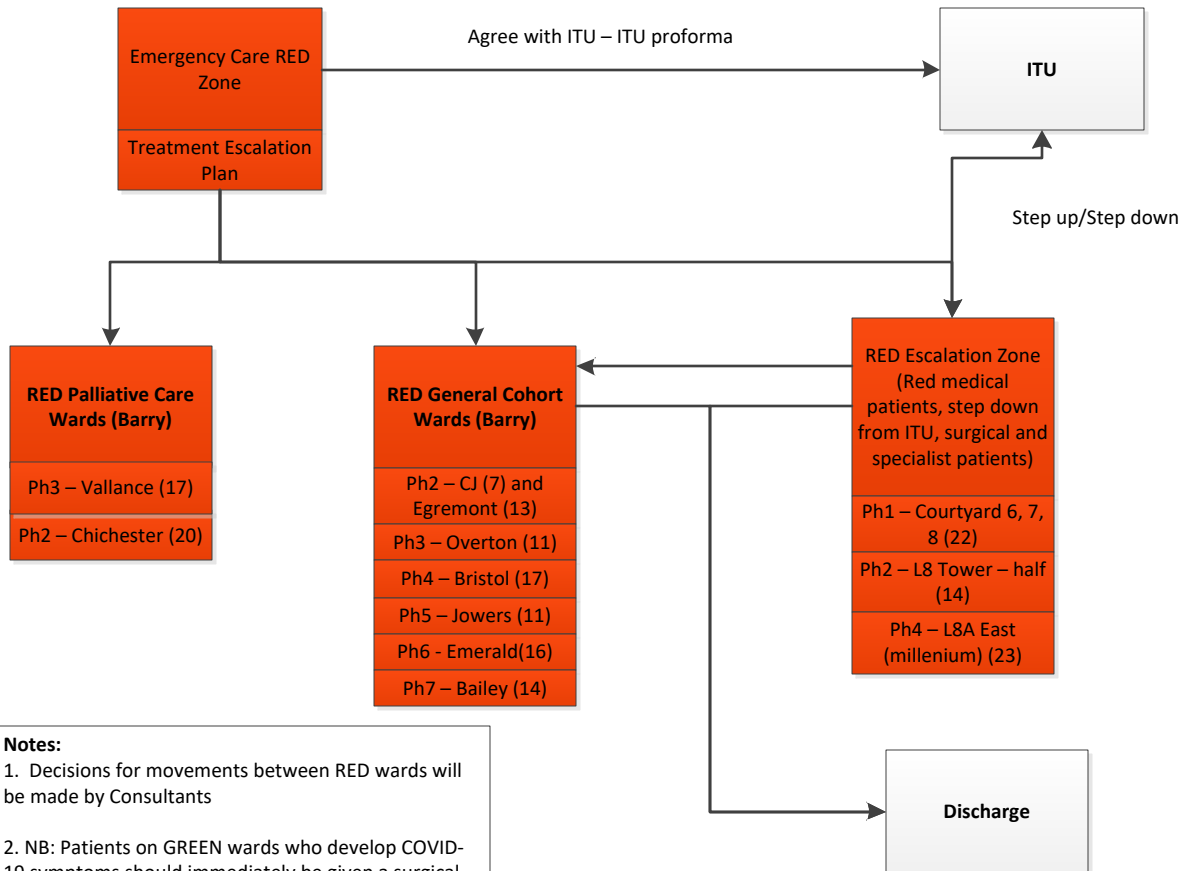


RSCH RED (COVID-19) Inpatient Pathway V0.5 (26/03/2020)

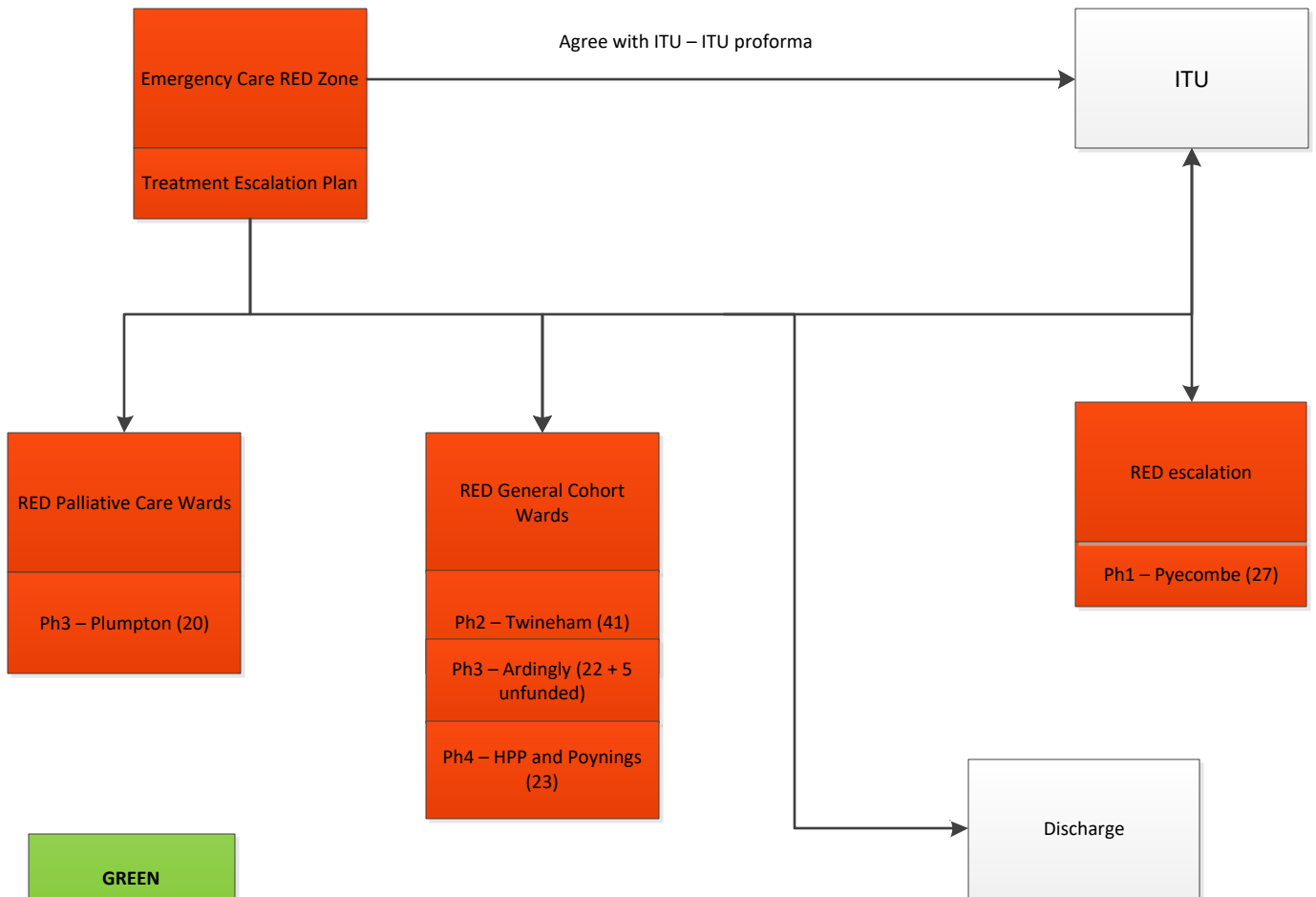
