- There is a basic allocation below, but please note that the Consultants and Registrars may ask for flexibility of staff depending on where the demand is greatest e.g. more juniors may be needed to support Medical Take if that's where the greatest Patient workload is
- Juniors can also expect to be moved between areas throughout the shift e.g. Once the Ward Round is complete in AAU then they may be asked to work in ED, this will be reviewed by the Consultants and Registrars and will take into account movement between Red/Green

<p>1. Red F2+ AAU</p>	<p>Bleep: 8820 Jobs: Support Medical ward round with <u>Frailty Medical Team</u>, action any jobs, Liaises with GREEN ED consultant after ward round and jobs</p>
<p>2. Red F1 (May be an F2)</p>	<p>Bleep: 8527 Jobs: Support Medical Ward Round with <u>Respiratory Medical Team</u>, action any jobs, reports to RED ED consultant after ward round and jobs</p>
<p>3. Red F2+ AAU Assessment/2B/MET</p>	<p>Bleep: 8980 Jobs: Support to all Medical Teams Patients presenting to the Red Zone under Medical Teams, <u>Hold the Red MET Bleep</u>, flex between Medical Teams depending on workload and MET calls</p>
<p>4. Red F1/F2+ AAU Assessment/2B</p>	<p>Bleep: N/A Jobs: See Patients presenting to the Red Zone, clerking</p>
<p>5. Red F2+ 2B</p>	<p>Bleep: N/A Jobs: See Patients presenting to the Red Zone, clerking</p>
<p>6. Green F1/F2+/Green MET bleep holder EACU</p>	<p>Bleep: 8520 Jobs: See Patients presenting to Green <u>EACU</u>, <u>hold the Green MET Bleep</u></p>
<p>7. Green F2+ UCC</p>	<p>Bleep: N/A Jobs: See Patients presenting to the Green Zone <u>UCC</u></p>
<p>8. Green F2+ 2A</p>	<p>Bleep: N/A Jobs: See Patients presenting to the Green Zone 2A, can flex to the Red Zones if needed</p>
<p>9. F2+/ Float</p>	<p>Bleep: N/A Jobs: Support Medical Ward Rounds/EACU if needed, or ED if not needed, AMT Consultant and ED Consultant to review throughout shift</p>
