How KnowledgeShare can support you during the coronavirus pandemic

Assigned Librarians can change their email address

If your LKS team is working with reduced staffing you can streamline emails from members who have replied to evidence updates. Simply change the email address of your assigned librarian(s) to your LKS generic email address, or the address of a team member providing cover.

Ask your members if they would like Covid-19 added to their professional interests

Many members won't have Covid-19 in their list of interests but may still wish to receive the latest on the outbreak. We recommend adding the following paragraph to your current awareness email template:

"A regularly updated list of Covid-19 publications can be found at www.knowledgeshare.nhs.uk/coronavirus_infections. If you would like to have Covid-19 added to your own interests, or to increase the frequency of updates, please let me know."

The list of Covid-10 resources doesn't require an OpenAthens account. It lists publications added to KnowledgeShare in date order.

Tell your members about changes to service provision or [opening hours](#)

You could also consider using the current awareness emails to share information about any closures and changes to your libraries' opening times.
