All minor injuries thought to require theatre will need senior clinician review. Discuss with CED Consultant to see if can be done in CED

#### **Out of Hours**

## All patients that are safe to be seen the next working day

- Please refer online via <u>Bamboo</u> (Panda > Bamboo forms > Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (OFMS) referral form). You can attach photos and notes.
- If you are unable to refer via Bamboo, use the email address below.
- If OMFS advice required, call QVH trauma coordinator who will escalate the case to the senior OMFS clinician at QVH to confirm that theatre is required or can be done at BSUH.

#### **Out of Hours**

## Patients that require more urgent assessment

- Contact the QVH trauma coordinator for referrals and advice.
- ENT are on call only for airway and bleeding issues
- Dental Injuries
  - → Emergency dental service call 111
  - → QVH trauma coordinator for issues such as adult tooth avulsion or displacement
- Facial or lip laceration crossing vermillion border or facial fractures (including orbital fractures but always contact Ophthalmology for blow out fractures).
  - → If this cannot be dealt with in CED discuss with local paediatric surgical registrar. Otherwise discuss with QVH trauma coordinator

This is a guide only. If you need maxillofacial advice, please bleep 8787 (during working hours) or call QVH. The trauma coordinator should be able to enable you to speak to an OMFS doctor on call.
