

Making a Neurology referral to the Evelina Children's Hospital

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Who can refer

We accept referrals from hospital-based paediatricians and other specialists.

Usually, we do not accept referrals directly from GPs unless they have had a recommendation from secondary providers to make the referral.

How to refer

Please address referrals for routine neurological problems (such as non-complex epilepsy, first seizure, non-complex headache) to general children's rather than children's neurology.

A 'first seizure' clinic, for children with their first possible epileptic attack is run by general paediatrics (by Dr John Jackman). Please address referrals to Dr Jackman in the first instance.
