### Category Q&A



How do I use the Settings categories?



When categorising a member, choosing *specific* Settings will increase the relevance of their updates. Try to avoid higher level settings, such as “Hospital Settings”, other than for people who truly work across the whole hospital.

You may have to choose the most appropriate categories based on job role, etc. if the member has not specified a setting.

When categorising a resource, do not select all Settings even if the resource does not specify a setting. Select the most suitable categories to ensure it goes to the right people, as no members will be working across every single setting.

Example: categories for a radiologist based in an acute trust:

**Age Groups**  
Age Groups

**Conditions and Lifestyle Factors**  
Cancer, Heart Diseases, Digestive System Diseases, Endocrine Diseases, Brain Diseases

**Settings**  
Hospital Ward, Intensive Care, Outpatient Department, Perioperative Setting

**Staff Groups**  
Radiologist, Radiotherapist
