Category Q&A



Which Settings category should I use for the imaging department?



Members with an interest in radiology or imaging (including x-ray, ultrasound, etc.) may specify their settings of interest, for example A&E, breast clinic, fracture clinic. Where possible you should select the corresponding setting(s) for these members, e.g. Emergency Department, Outpatient Department, Community Clinics.

Where no specific setting is requested, choose Outpatient Department. You can also select Outpatient Department when categorising resources about imaging as a department or specialism. Combine your settings categories with Radiologist and/or Radiographer or their narrower staff group terms as appropriate.

Sharing evidence search reports via KnowledgeShare

Health Education England would like work done by NHS librarians to have a wide impact. With this in mind, your teams can now share completed search reports via KnowledgeShare more widely.

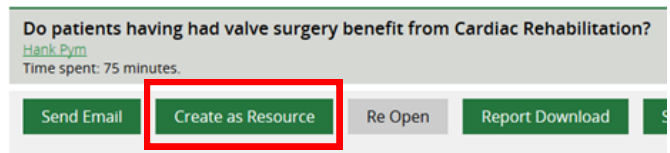
Instead of a search report benefiting only local staff, reports can now appear in evidence update emails across England and Wales. They simply need to be categorised.

All completed reports are shareable according to GDPR. The name of the requester cannot be shared without permission, which is why we hide this by default.

If you would like to share search reports you should attend training on resource categorisation (see below for dates). Once you have these skills:

- Select the completed searches that you think will have a wider appeal
- Provide a concise but informative title that captures the search request
- Ensure there is no personally identifiable information in the search notes or summary
- Ensure the search doesn't refer to previous searches
- Use the search notes to explain searching decisions, e.g. "A brief literature search" or "Only systematic reviews have been included".
