

The child/young person bereavement pack should contain:

Leaflets:

- Cruse Bereavement Care contact details and “Somewhere to turn when someone dies” leaflet
- Book of remembrance leaflet
- Registering a Death website details

If deemed appropriate, one can also include:

- A Sudden End to Breastfeeding leaflet
- Lullaby Trust “Bereavement Support” leaflet
- Child Bereavement Charity “When a Child or Young Person is Bereaved” and “Telephone Support for Parents/Carers” leaflets
- Chestnut Tree House “Bereavement Services” and “Supporting families when their child dies” leaflets

All available in the optional leaflets folder in CED.

Memento box containing:

- Photographs
- Lock of hair
- Foot and hand prints (laminated or imprinted block)
- Worn name bands / clothing - check with Police as may be kept

All items should be offered prior to placing in the box. Not all parents will want photographs for example.
