How do I categorise health inequalities?



We have made some changes to the Lifestyle and Risks section of the category tree, including renaming Populations & Demography to **Populations & Health Inequalities**. Members who are interested in health inequalities affecting all minority groups should be given this category.

You can also select more specific child terms, including Gender, Race & Ethnicity, Disabled People, Migrants, and Travellers & Nomadic People.



See also the Social Problems category and its child terms, including Poverty and Homelessness.

The free text box above the Professional Interest categories can be used in two ways.

1. Members can record their interests and requests here when they log in, using their own words. If a Member makes a change in this box, their assigned Librarian receives an email prompting them to create or update the categories accordingly. If the Member doesn't have an assigned librarian, the LKS Admin will receive an email notifying them that one needs to be assigned.
