### Evidence Search is now compatible with native interface search histories

The search history field has been redeveloped as part of the work on evidence search functionality to ensure KnowledgeShare can support the native databases, after HDAS is retired.

Search histories from all sources can now be pasted directly into the search history field on the search results tab. After pasting the search history click "Save Search History".

Please ensure the search history pasted in the field includes:

- Name of database(s) used
- Number of results
- How search strings are combined
