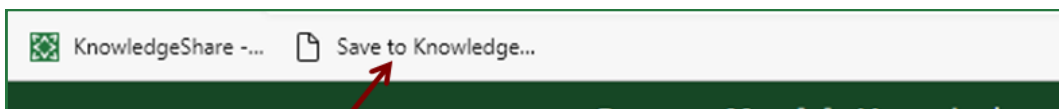

Using a bookmarklet to add a result to an evidence search

The bookmarklet function stores the citation of individual articles and allows you to import them into an evidence search using the Structured Search Result.

Before a bookmarklet can be used, the Save to KnowledgeShare link must be added to your browser's bookmark / favourites tool bar. Go to the Evidence > Bookmarked Resources page. Click and drag the Save to KnowledgeShare link to the bookmark / favourites bar on your browser.

Category Q&A



How should the categories within Neurodevelopmental Disorders be used?



We have recently made changes to this part of the category tree (previously Developmental Disorders) which should help guide usage.

Developmental Disabilities has been renamed to **Intellectual Disabilities**. Use this for the long-term care and support of people with Down Syndrome and similar conditions. Use Down Syndrome under Inborn Genetic Diseases for diagnostic, genetic and medical aspects.

Use **Autism** for any autistic spectrum disorder including Aspergers. Combine with the appropriate age groups, settings and staff groups to indicate the level and type of intervention or support involved.

Learning Disorders (referring to dyslexia etc) has been moved out of this area and placed under Education. Do not use for learning disabilities.

For social care and issues of rights and identity, see also **People with Special Needs** and **Disabled People** under Populations & Health Inequalities.
