Training demonstrations for library and knowledge service staff

We run regular online demonstrations **for LKS staff** on KnowledgeShare functionality, via MS Teams and Zoom.

Evidence Search

These 2-hour sessions are offered twice a month. The session includes a presentation on how KnowledgeShare supports evidence search management, and a live demo. The demo covers: adding and managing search requests, adding results via RIS import and individually, adding supporting information such as search strategies and summaries, and sending the final report to the requester.

Skills

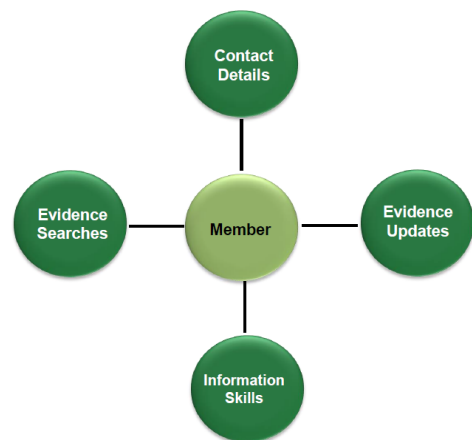
90-minute sessions offered once a month. The session includes a short presentation on how KnowledgeShare supports skills session administration, and a live demo. The demo covers: creating skills session templates and individual sessions, recording bookings and attendance, providing certificates, and entering feedback.

Local Resources

90-minute sessions offered every two months. The session includes a presentation on adding your own resources to KnowledgeShare for local distribution, and a live demo. The demo covers: adding physical and online books, adding organisational guidelines and policies, and adding events. It also provides an introduction to categorising resources so they are matched to the right members.

How do I categorise nerve-centred pain?

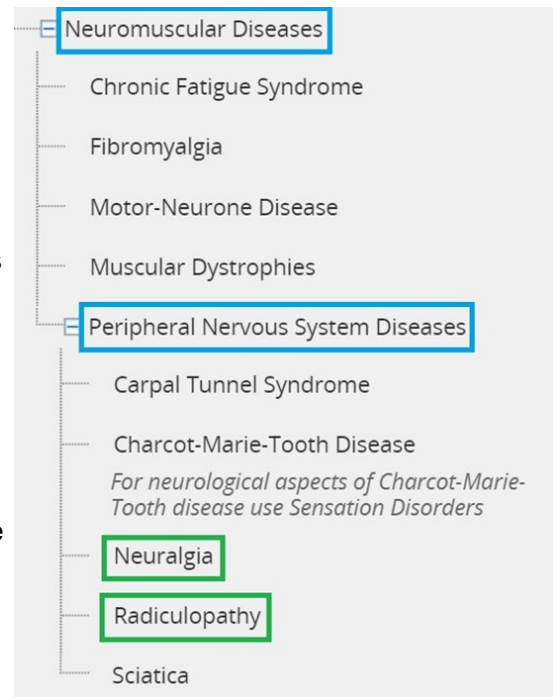


KnowledgeShare has expanded its taxonomy in line with MeSH to distinguish pain that relates to common forms of nerve injury. In addition to the existing Pain section under Nervous System Diseases, we have added Radiculopathy and duplicated Neuralgia under Neuromuscular Diseases to reflect this.

Categories added:

Neuralgia: Generalised pain that occurs along the course or distribution of a peripheral or cranial nerve.

Radiculopathy: Compression of a nerve in the spine that causes pain, weakness or sensation loss elsewhere in the peripheral nervous system.

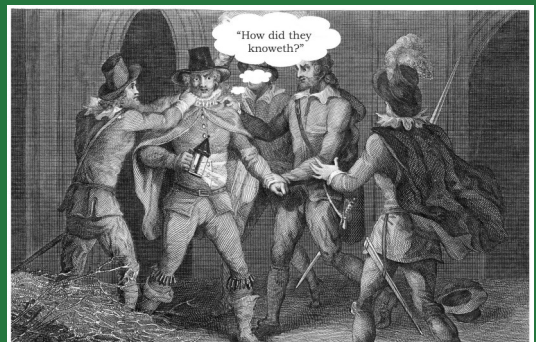
