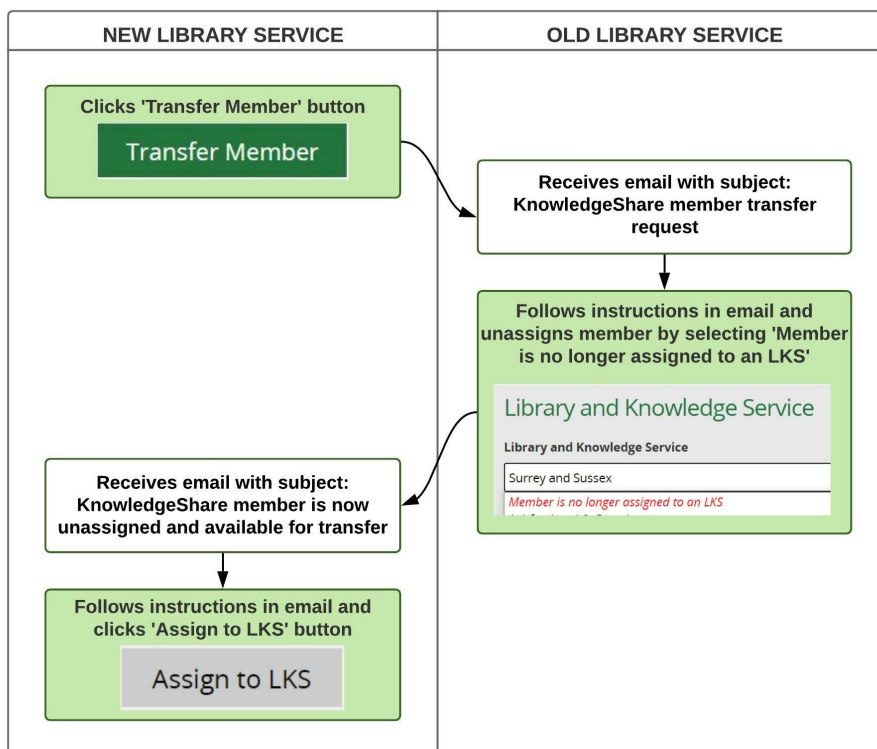

Which **Medic / Dentist** staff group categories should I select when categorising a doctor?

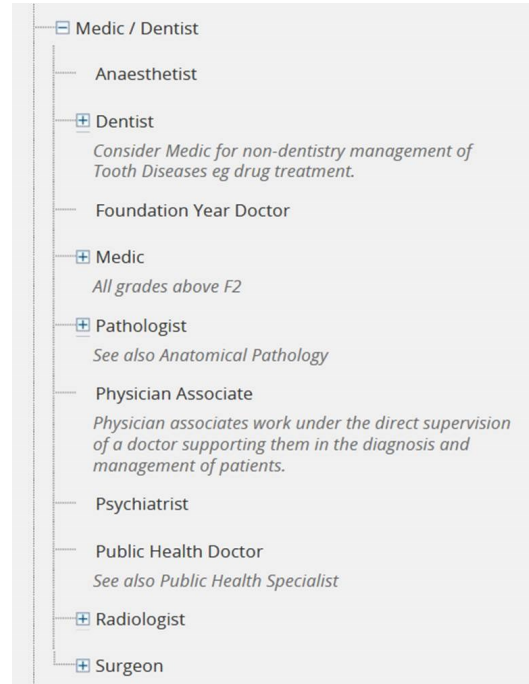


Do not use the top level **Medic / Dentist** category as this is too broad to provide relevant updates. Use **Medic** for most physicians at all levels above Foundation Year 2. This includes Core and Specialty Trainees, Clinical Fellows, Specialty Registrars, GPs and Consultants.

Foundation Year Doctor should be used for F1 and F2 trainees to ensure they receive resources at the right level, but you may want to combine this with other staff groups to capture a specific interest.

The following specialisms have their own categories: **Anaesthetist, Dentist, Pathologist, Psychiatrist, Radiologist** and **Surgeon**. **Physician Associate** and **Public Health Doctor** are also available.

Some interventions in the medical/surgical skill set are provided as child terms, for example **Transfusion Medicine** and **Transplants**.
