CARE OF LYMPHOMA INPATIENTS AT RSCH/PRH (UHSussex)

The lymphoma clinic is run by both haematology and oncology and works as a unified out-patient team with dedicated CNS and Macmillan Support Worker.

Because patients are seen and treated by 2 different teams, this causes some confusion when patients are admitted to hospital in terms of who looks after in-patients.

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This document hopes to clarify this and stands irrespective of leave / who has seen patient in clinic/ who has prescribed any chemo.

- Please ensure an Acute Oncology Bamboo referral is completed for any Cancer patient or suspected cancer patient admitted to Hospital.
