

FIXATION OF TESTES DISCHARGE ADVICE

Your son has undergone surgery to fix either one or both of his testicles to the scrotal wall to prevent them from twisting in the future.

- ✍ After discharge from hospital your son may go back to playgroup, or nursery.
- ✍ The stitches DO NOT NEED TO BE REMOVED. They will dissolve over a period of time.
- ✍ If you are worried about the wound, for example, it looks red and angry or if there is a discharge, please contact your GP.
- ✍ Washing the wound at nappy changes is fine but try not to soak the wound site. No baths for 5 days.
- ✍ Your child may experience some discomfort and bruising for the first week after the operation.
- ✍ To help to prevent discomfort you can give Paracetamol at the intervals stated on the bottle.
