### **Executive summary**

The purpose of this paper is to present the Board of Directors with the BSUH Annual Plan for 2015/16.

This plan will be submitted to the NHS Trust Development Authority as an annual operating plan for BSUH.

The Annual Plan sets out operational priorities for the Trust over the financial year 2015/16. The plan builds on the Foundations for Success programme commenced last year, introduces new Trust Objectives, priorities and Key Impact Programmes that are focused on securing sustainable improvements in performance against core constitutional targets and safety & quality measures.

The Annual Plan sets out a financial plan for next year. The Trust will aim to achieve a break-even position in 2015/16, with a continuity of services risk rating of 3.

The indicative activity plan assumes that the Trust will be able to receive £440m of clinical related income from commissioners, accounting for growth, any known and commissioned service changes, recovery of RTT, CQUINs, etc. There is a level of risk associated with the income, particularly around Better Care Fund, re-investment of penalties, and changes to MSK services.

The Plan provides an overview of delivery and governance arrangements that will be put in place to provide scrutiny and oversight for programmes required to deliver the Trust Objectives in 2015/16.
