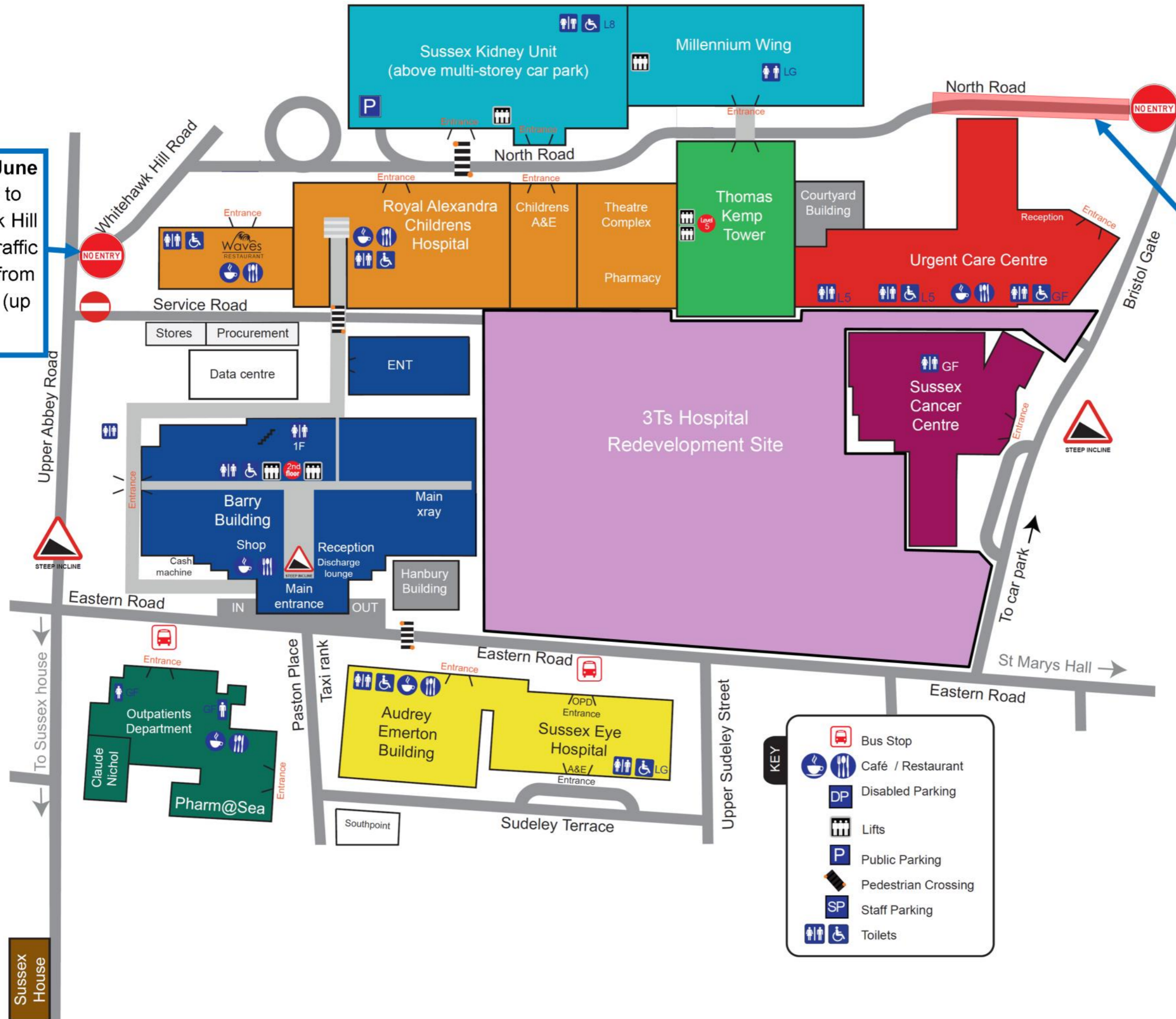


# Royal Sussex County Hospital

# The Royal Sussex County Hospital Changes to Car Parking

## Monday 12th June to Sunday 25th June 2017

From Monday 12th June until Sunday 25th June the normal route to the multi-storey car park, from Bristol Gate across the hospital site, will be shut. This is to allow the delivery of large modules for a new building in the hospital.

During this period drivers should follow the signposted route (shown in blue to the right) to reach the hospital's multi-storey car park.

To help manage traffic during this period:

- The bottom of Whitehawk Hill Road will be made one way (from north to south), as shown in red to the right.
- Parking bays next to the hospital on both Upper Abbey Road and Whitehawk Hill Road will be suspended.

Please allow extra time if you are driving to the hospital and wish to park in the multi-storey car park.
