

Further Inpatient Rehabilitation Services

What happens after your stay at the Sussex Rehabilitation Centre (SRC)

Where will I go after the SRC?

Once you have completed your treatment at the Sussex Rehabilitation Centre, your consultant and therapists have recommended that you have more rehabilitation at a community inpatient specialist placement. This type of rehabilitation is called **Slow Stream rehabilitation**.

A referral will be sent on your behalf by the Sussex Rehabilitation Centre Discharge Co-ordinator to the Acquired Brain Injury Co-ordinator. They will agree:

- Funding: how your care will be paid for
- Where you will go: which placement meets your needs.

Will I be close to my home?

The Co-ordinators will make every effort for the placement to be close to your home address. Sometimes this is not possible as there are not a lot of specialist rehabilitation facilities in our region. There can also be a waiting list for a bed to become available. However, we will always try to make a placement with your best interests in mind.

How long will I be staying at the specialist placement?

The length of your stay at the specialist placement will be based on your progress. You will have re-assessments at various stages during your stay by the Acquired Brain injury Co-ordinator.
